

NOAA Nautical Charting Calendar

On-Line ChartViewer

NOAA posts all of its nautical charts on the Internet for free viewing. Only an Internet browser and Adobe Flash Player are needed to rapidly display, pan and zoom, and open multiple charts. Print a “screen capture” to take with you for ready reference.

Charts in the ChartViewer are updated for all Notices to Mariners and new editions. Corrections originating with NOAA are posted even before they are published in the Local Notice to Mariners.

Approximately 10,000 chart corrections are made and posted annually, and an average of 300 new editions are issued. The Internet address for this free public service is <http://ocsddata.ncd.noaa.gov/OnLineViewer/>.
